Irons

Irons are machines that use heat to get the wrinkles out of clothes and other materials.

Early irons were flat pieces of iron with metal handles. The iron was held over a fire until it was hot, then it was run across the top of clothes. These irons were heavy, not very safe and could easily burn clothing.

Later, people used **charcoal** or **spirits**, such as oil or petrol, to heat their irons.

Heating up an iron could be dangerous work.
